

## Policies and Procedures for Indoor Worship

- Everyone should check their temperatures on Sunday morning before coming to church. We will have two forehead thermometers on hand in case you need us to check your temperature. We are asking anyone that is experiencing temperature of 100.0 F or greater, respiratory illness, shortness of breath, fever, cough, sore throat, loss of taste/smell to stay home. If you have been in contact with anyone that has tested positive or have traveled out of the state to one of the restricted states or out of the country, please stay home.
- Masks are mandatory for all people over 2 years old. Masks should cover nose and mouth and should be worn in the building at all times.
- We will have hand sanitizer available in several places in the building. You are not required to use hand sanitizer. It is there for anyone who desires to use it.
- Everyone must enter through the door by the mailbox that leads to the parking lot. Then walk up the stairs and enter through the front of the sanctuary. Doors will be propped open. Seating will start in the back of the sanctuary and work its way toward the front of the church. We will exit in the opposite direction. People in the front will exit first. We will be seating you at least 6 feet away from those who are outside of your household or bubble.
- There will be no fellowship or socializing in the church building. No coffee or snacks will be served. No hanging out in the sanctuary before/after service.
- Doors will open at 10:05 AM for seating. We will have greeters/ushers who will help you to your seat. Please let me know if you would like to be an usher/greeter.
- Since we are limited to the number of people able to attend in person worship, please RSVP by emailing Gabi at [fbcpitman@verizon.net](mailto:fbcpitman@verizon.net) between Wednesday at 12pm and Friday at 12pm and wait for her to confirm your reservation. We also have a form on the [website](#). Please let us know if things change and you are no longer able to attend.
- Bathrooms in the entryway will be closed. Bathroom in the sanctuary will be open in case of emergency.
- B.Y.O.B (Bible)- There will be no Bibles in the sanctuary. Please bring your own Bible or use one on your cell phone. We will also look to have it projected on the screen.
- No bulletins- we will not be offering any bulletins. Announcements will continue to be dispersed through email and social media.
- We will not be passing the offering plate but will use the same offering box that we have been using outside. - In this first phase of reopening, there will be no music. Our time together will consist of prayer, Scripture, Children's Message, and Sermon (and possibly other creative ways for us to worship safely)
- There will be no childcare or children's church during this first phase of reopening. Children will have to remain with parents or guardians for the duration of the service.
- The sanctuary and entryway will be cleaned and sanitized between Sundays.

- Since we are concerned about ventilation, the windows in the back of the sanctuary will be opened and will have box fans running in them. Therefore, we advise you to wear a coat and bring a blanket if needed.
- We will continue to live stream to Facebook and YouTube each Sunday.
